

The information below aims to provide answers to any questions you may have.

We will hold a **College Transfer Information session on 30 September and 1 October which we strongly recommend you attend**. The session will provide an opportunity for you to ask more detailed questions if you have any.

How do I know if the transition impacts me?

- **If you are completing your studies in the current study period, you are not impacted by transition.** There will be no changes to your current program or your progression to your next. Everything will continue as planned.
- **If you are studying in a Diploma or Graduate Certificate Program in 2025 and will not complete in the current study period, transition may apply to you.** We will work closely with you to explain and support you through each step. Our aim is to make this process as smooth and stress-free as possible.

When do I transition to Eynesbury College (EC)?

- Students studying Diploma of Business, Diploma of Information Technology, and Diploma of Engineering (students with Stage 2 modules remaining), will transfer in Trimester 3 2025 (October). All other students will transfer in Trimester 1 2026 (February).

How does the transfer from SAIBT to EC work?

- To continue your studies as planned, you will be required to accept a new Letter of Offer for EC. This offer will contain specific details related to your enrolment (key dates, program, module credit, fees etc.). Once you accept your new EC offer containing details of your EC program, your updated Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) will be sent to you. Your EC CoE will be in effect for the remainder of your program.

How can I accept my Letter of Offer for EC?

- Your Letter of Offer will be sent to the personal email address you provided SAIBT. **To accept the offer, you will need to sign your acceptance and email to eynesbury.studentservices@navitas.com within 24-48 hours.** Please note, your offer cannot be accepted by an education agent, it can only be accepted by you. If you are transitioning in Trimester 3 2025 (October) **you may also accept your Letter of Offer at one of the College Transfer Information sessions where a print copy will be provided to you.** Please see further information including Transition Information session details below.

Will I receive credits for the modules I've completed with SAIBT? Will my letter of Offer display my credits?

- Yes, you will receive credits for the modules you have successfully completed in your current Letter of Offer for EC. The credits for completed modules will be displayed on your Letter of Offer as RPL (Recognition of Prior Learning). What you will see on your offer will be the equivalent new module at EC. You are advised to download and save a copy of your transcript for the SAIBT program for your records. You can also request a copy of your transcript from SAIBT. There are **two College Transfer Information sessions on the 30 September 2025 and 1 October 2025** where more information will be provided. **It is strongly recommended that you attend one of these sessions.** You will receive an email with further details about the sessions shortly.

How does this impact my CoE and student visa?

- EC will issue you with a new CoE for the remainder of your pathway program, and package. Your SAIBT and package CoE will then be cancelled.
- We recommend that you contact the [Department of Home Affairs](#) should you have any questions related to your student visa.

Academic Questions

Where will I be able to see module credits in my new enrolment?

- The credit you receive for completed modules at SAIBT will be visible in the EC student portal. This will appear as RPL (Recognition of Prior Learning). It's

important you save a copy of your unofficial academic transcript from the SAIBT student portal.

Will the modules change? If yes, how does that affect my progression to EC?

- Some modules have been updated to align with EC, but this will not affect your progression to Adelaide University.

What will my academic transcript look like?

- Your final transcript when you complete your program with EC will show all the modules you completed at EC and the credit you received for modules completed with SAIBT. To see all your grades for every module, you will need a transcript from SAIBT for studies completed up to your transfer to EC and from EC for studies you complete thereafter.

Progression to Adelaide University

Will the transition affect my academic progress? Will I be delayed?

- All your studies at SAIBT are recognised by EC so the transition will not affect your academic progress provided you successfully complete all your modules.

Does Adelaide University accept my combined studies from SAIBT and EC?

- Yes, EC has worked closely with Adelaide University to ensure that your studies from SAIBT and EC will be recognised. There are agreements in place to ensure this.

What happens if I don't want to continue my studies with EC?

- You have the choice to not accept the EC Letter of Offer sent to you. There are **two College Transfer Information sessions on the 30 September 2025 and 1 October 2025** where more information will be provided. **It is strongly recommended that you attend one of these sessions.** This additional information will allow you to make an informed decision. You will receive an email with further details about the sessions shortly. If you're not sure about transferring to EC, you may also contact the Student and Academic Services team to find out more about the potential consequences on your CoE or any refund of your tuition fees.

Financial Questions

Are there any fees associated with my new EC offer?

- There are no additional fees associated with your new EC offer.

Can Domestic Students access FEE-HELP for Diploma programs at EC?

- Yes. You will need to complete a new eCAF (electronic Commonwealth Assistance Form) for EC as part of your enrolment. The Student and Academic Services team will guide you through this process. There are **two College Transfer Information sessions on the 30 September 2025 and 1 October 2025** where more information will be provided. **It is strongly recommended that you attend one of these sessions.** You will receive an email with further details about the sessions shortly.

Will my existing SAIBT scholarship discount transfer to EC?

- If you hold a scholarship discount for your enrolment with SAIBT, it will be rolled over into your enrolment with EC.

Will my existing SAIBT sponsorship transfer to EC?

- If you hold a sponsorship for your enrolment with SAIBT and you transfer to EC, you will require a new Financial Guarantee from your Sponsor. The Student and Academic Services team will guide you through this process.

What are the new key calendar dates? When are my breaks etc.?

Will I lose access to all my logins (LMS, student account, etc.)? What are the new systems for me?

- At EC you will be using the new EC Moodle page. You will receive information about your access details when you enrol.

Will I need a new student ID card?

- If your study is confirmed for delivery at City East Campus, you will not need a new student ID card in 2025. You will be issued with a new EC student ID number

however your university ID which is displayed on your student ID card will remain unchanged. Further information will be provided to you as part of the Letter of Offer acceptance process.

- If your study is confirmed for delivery at Coglein Street (Stage 1 Diploma of Business & Diploma of IT), you will be issued with a student ID/access card. Further information will be provided to you as part of the enrolment process.

How do I enrol in modules?

- For enrolment in modules at EC, you'll be using your new student portal at EC. The process is identical to what you are used to at SAIBT. If you need assistance, please contact the Student Academic and Services team.
